## One For The Many!

John 11:45-57

**John 20:19-20 (NLT)** ... “That evening, on the first day of the week, the disciples were meeting behind **locked doors** because they were **afraid** of the Jewish leaders. **Suddenly, Jesus was standing there among them!** ‘Peace be with you,’ he said. [20] As he spoke, he held out his hands for them to see, and he showed them his side. They were filled with joy when they **saw** their Lord!”

**Q ... How do you ignore a man that was truly dead but later was alive again?**

As we look farther into this eleventh chapter of **John**, what you will see is that the various reactions of the Jewish people to **Jesus** after He raised Lazarus from the dead are pretty much the typical responses that we see today.

**I.** (45) There were \_\_\_\_\_ that responded to Him with faith.

**Acts 4:12 (NCV)** ... “**Jesus** is the **only One** who can save people. His name is the only power in the world that has been given to save people. **We must be saved through him.**”

**God** has only sent \_\_\_\_\_ Savior!

**Romans 3:23-25a (NLT)** ... “For all have sinned; all fall short of God’s glorious standard. [24] Yet now God in his gracious kindness declares us **not guilty**. He has done this through **Christ Jesus**, who has freed us by taking away our sins. [25] For **God sent Jesus** to take the punishment for our sins and to satisfy God’s anger against us.

We are made right with God when we **believe** that Jesus shed his blood, sacrificing his life for us.”

**Romans 10:8a, 9-11 (NLT)** ... “Salvation .. comes from trusting Christ ... [9] For if you **confess** with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and **believe** in your heart that God raised him from the dead, **you will be saved**. [10] For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by confessing with your mouth that you are saved. [11] As the Scriptures tell us, “Anyone who believes in him will not be disappointed.”

II. (46-54) There were others that willfully accepted the role of \_\_\_\_\_.

**Homer Kent** ... *The chief cause of unbelief is not inadequate information, but a **heart in rebellion** against the authority of God and His word.*

**Galatians 1:4 (NLT)** ... “He died for our sins, just as God our Father **planned**, in order to rescue us from this evil world in which we live.”

**John 14:19a (NIV)** ... “**Because I live, you also will live.**”

**Matthew 12:30 (NLT)** ... “**Anyone who isn't helping me opposes me, and anyone who isn't working with me is actually working against me.**”

**Luke 16:13 (NCV)** ... “**No servant can serve two masters. The servant will hate one master and love the other, or will follow one master and refuse to follow the other. You cannot serve both God and worldly riches.**”

**John 3:16-17 (NCV)** ... “**God loved the world so much that he gave his one and only Son so that whoever believes in him may not be lost, but have eternal life. [17] God did not send his Son into the world to judge the world guilty, but to save the world through him.**”

**Dwight L. Moody** ... *I am only one, but I am one. I cannot do everything, but I can do something. And that which I can do, by the grace of God I will do.*

**Romans 5:15-17 (NLT)** ... “*And what a difference between our sin and God's generous gift of forgiveness. For this one man, Adam, brought death to many through his sin. But this other man, Jesus Christ, brought forgiveness to many through God's bountiful gift. [16] And the result of God's gracious gift is very different from the result of that one man's sin. For Adam's sin led to condemnation, but we have the free gift of being accepted by God, even though we are guilty of many sins. [17] The sin of this one man, Adam, caused death to rule over us, but all who receive God's wonderful, gracious gift of righteousness will live in triumph over sin and death through this one man, Jesus Christ.*”
